

CONTEXT


Pomezia and Santa Palomba belong to the Metropolitan City of Rome.

Pomezia is a città di fondazione (founded during Fascism in 1938). A strong industrialisation of the territory continued until the 1990s thanks to the funds for the Cassa del Mezzogiorno. Pomezia is an industrial city, especially in the pharmaceutical and medical sector, paper manufacturing, food processing, and it has an important agricultural sector.
